### GALWAY'S DOG SHOW

**URBAN COUNCIL OPENING SUCCESSFUL VENTURE LARGE ATTENDANCE.**

Galway's first annual dog show opened in Eyre Square on Thursday in beautiful weather. Exhibitors from all parts of Great Britain and Ireland attended and packed the spacious square from an early hour.

The show was wonderfully successful and the excellence of the organization was a striking tribute to the tireless energy of the popular hon. secretary (Mr. L. Hynes) and his capable committee.

Mr. Joseph's Industrial School Band, Saltihill, under the direction of Mr. D. P. Kelly, attended.

At 11 o'clock the show was officially opened by Mr. Martin J. Cooke, chairman of the Galway Urban Council, who said: "I have been requested to open this show on behalf of the Urban Council. It may be asked, 'What interest can the Galway Urban Council possibly have in a dog show?' but the answer to such a question would be that the Urban Council have a very material interest in anything calculated to further advertise the city amongst those who already know it, and to bring it to the notice of those who know nothing of its existence beyond the somewhat large, geographical knowledge that Galway is somewhere in Ireland."

A maritime city like Galway, and, more particularly, our suburb, Saltihill, depends very extensively on its tourist traffic and anything, therefore, that tends to improve the traffic and the benefits that must undoubtedly follow is worthy of the support of every good citizen (hear, hear). The fact that the Galway Dog Show Society, on this, its first venture, has been responsible for a great deal of publicity for Galway and Saltihill is a matter on which they deserve the heartiest congratulation. That this show will be a successful success, that it will be but the forerunner of even greater successes and that our many visitors whom we heartily welcome, will thoroughly enjoy their stay amongst us, is my sincerest wish. Before I conclude I would like to express my appreciation of the ability of Mr. Larry Hynes and his committee who organized this show and brought it to such a successful conclusion. I have no great pleasure in declaring the first Galway Dog Show officially open.

Mr. Cooke then cut the ribbon that spanned the ribbon gate to the grounds, and the show commenced.

**Visitor's Tribute.** Judging opened immediately and continued without a break throughout the day.

Eyre Square presented a gay scene, the different colours of the dogs making a gay commingling of different hues. The Galway Dog Show, in the words of Mr. Carbery of "The Irish Field," was one of the best provincial shows in Ireland. "The rings were beautifully laid out," said Mr. Carbery, "and the spectators were well catered for. I would like to pay a tribute to Mr. Hynes, the hon. secretary. He is really a wonderful organizer and the success of the show was due to Mr. Hynes and the grand publicity drive he gave the show."

The numerous stewards, judges, etc., all worked like trojans to make the show a success. It is only right to pay a tribute to Miss Fardie, Mr. Hynes's assistant, who was very helpful.

The 650 entries included animals from Northern Ireland, England, Scotland and Wales. Irish setters headed the list with an entry of 60, while there were 43 fox terriers, 30 cocker spaniels, and 30 greyhounds. An outstanding feature of the show was the large number of local entries, over 100 dogs being exhibited from Galway area. There were thus excursions from many parts of the country.
